Executive Order

1992-3

WHEREAS, the preservation and storage of State records is essential, both for the sake of history and the daily operation of State government; and

WHEREAS, there are a number of problems that need to be addressed in the current State method of preserving and storing State records; and

WHEREAS, the National Historical Publications and Records Commission has granted the Wyoming Department of Commerce \$9,720 to cover the cost of travel and meeting expenses for a board which would address these problems; and


WHEREAS, Wyoming currently lacks such an advisory board.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MIKE SULLIVAN, Governor of Wyoming, under the authority vested in me by the laws and Constitution of Wyoming, do hereby order that within State government:

1. A Wyoming State Historical Records Advisory Board be created within the Department of Commerce;
2. The Board will represent a broad spectrum of public and private institutions; and
3. The Governor will appoint the Board members and a State Coordinator for the Board.
